Detailed itinerary



Option 1

Day 1 (-/-/-) Bangkok – Aranyaprathet border of Thailand – Poipet – Siem Reap

Meet at Poi Pet, the Thailand – Cambodia border. You will cross the border and arrange their visa formalities. After crossing the border you will meet a tour guide that is waiting for you in front of the visa center.

Transfer to Siem Reap. Upon arrival in Siem Reap, there will be a transfer to the hotel for check-in (*after 2:00pm*). Visit in the late afternoon the hill temple of Phnom Bakheng (part of the Angkor Historical Park) for stunning views of the sunset over Angkor.

Overnight in Siem Reap, Steun Siem Reap (or similar) – Superior Room



Day 2 (B/-/-) Half day Tour Angkor Wat – Siem Reap – Poipet border of Cambodia

After breakfast in the hotel you will go on a trip to Angkor Wat, a temple dedicated to the Hindu God Vishnu by King Suryavarman II, who reigned between 1131 and 1150. It was constructed over a period of 30 years and is world famous for its beauty and splendor. Angkor Wat features the longest continuous bas-relief in the world, which runs along the outer gallery walls and narrates stories from Hindu mythology. In 1992 the UNESCO declared the monument and the whole city of Angkor a World Heritage Site. The **South Gate** with its huge statues depicting the churning of the ocean of milk, the **Bayon Temple**, unique for its 54 towers decorated with over 200 smiling faces of Avolokitesvara.

Transfer back to Poipet the border of Cambodia. Arrive at the Poi Pet border for your next trip to Bangkok (Thailand)



Option 2

Day 1 (-/-/-) Bangkok – Aranyaprathet border of Thailand – Poipet – Siem Reap

The itinerary of day 1 remains the same as the first day of option 1, described above.

Overnight in Siem Reap, Steun Siem Reap (or similar) – Superior Room

Day 2 (B/-/-) Half day Tour Angkor Wat – Siem Reap – Bangkok

After your visit of Angkor Wat as described above, transfer to Siem Reap airport for your evening flight to Bangkok (*flight TBA / not included*).



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
